BIOGRAPHY



Olivia Maëlle Breleur was born into the art world. Daughter of an artist, she does not escape his destiny.

After obtaining her diploma in fine arts, Olivia Maëlle Breleur decides to leave the practical side and deepen the theoretical knowledge. She studied in Paris at the EAC, school of communication, culture and luxury, where she was awarded a master in art market. She worked for art gallery and international art fair specialized in contemporary drawing.

In October 2012, at the age of 26, she founded and now runs the Maëlle Galerie which is installed since March 2014 in the district of Belleville, in the East side.

At present there are 14 artists originating from France, Brazil, Poland, Australia, Spain and the Caribbean.

Gender, femininity, identity, intimacy and finitude are amongst the themes explored. Her whole aim is to 'outline an artistic approach that in its moments of fragility or strength, but with some accuracy reflect what she sees as a proposal.' In parallel, working as exhibition curator affords her the freedom to extrapolate her vision on other horizons.
